1.) Shoebox: Get a standard size shoebox to pack for a boy or a girl. Need Shoeboxes? Shoeboxes will be available at the church soon.

2.) Shoebox Gift Ideas:

- "Wow" Items. Soccer Ball w/Pump, Doll, Stuffed Animal, Shoes.
- Toys: Toy Cars, Jump Ropes, Yo-Yos, Toys that light up and make noise (with extra batteries).
- Personal Care Items: Toothbrushes, Washcloths, Combs, Hairbrushes.
- School Supplies: Pens, pencils, sharpeners, crayons & markers. Notebooks & Paper, Color & Picture Books, Solar Calculators.
- Accessories: Socks, Sunglasses, Jewelry & Watches, Flashlights with extra batteries.
- VERY IMPORTANT ITEMS <u>DO NOT INCLUDE IN SHOEBOXES</u> Candy, gum, toothpaste, Used or Damaged items, Scary or War-related items, Seeds, Food, Liquids or Lotions, Medications or Vitamins, Glass containers, Aerosol Cans.

3.) PRAY: Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift. Include a personal note or photo to delight the heart of a child.

4.) DONATE \$10 PER BOX : To cover shipping costs

5.) COLLECTION: Filled Boxes are due November 13th


Annual Waynesboro Holiday Parade
